- Leadership and teamwork



All modern airlines assess their pilots against these core competencies, and the exercises and sim checks in airline interviews are designed to do exactly the same thing.

You are assessed against these competencies during initial Assessment with Wings Alliance. If weaknesses are found, we work with you and your trainers during your flying courses to build up your experience and skills.
